Recreation User Fees

Recreation User Fee Schedule Policy

Purpose

To establish the 2011/12 recreation user fee schedule for BC Parks.

Group camping fee changes are effective January 1, 2011. All other fees are effective March 15, 2011.

Scope

This policy applies to the individually listed BC Parks, Recreation Areas and Conservancies.

This policy establishes the fee schedule for all recreation user fees being charged by BC Parks (e.g. nightly camping fees, moorage, day use shelter rentals, etc.) other than day use parking and annual parking passes which are set in regulation.

Definitions

"**adult**" means a person who is 16 years of age or older;

"**backcountry**" means an area in a park, conservancy or recreation area that is not frontcountry;

"**campsite**" means an area in a park, conservancy or recreation area developed by the ministry to accommodate persons who wish to camp;

"**child**" mean a person who is under 16 years of age;

"**frontcountry**" means an area in a park, conservancy or recreation area within one kilometre of either side of the centreline of a park road or a highway;

"**group**" means 15 or more persons;

"**off season**" means the period from the day after Labour Day to June 14 of the following year;

"**party**" means up to 8 persons, of whom at least one, but no more than 4, are 16 years old or older, and who may have with them

- (a) one recreational vehicle,
- (b) one non-recreational vehicle, or
- (c) one non-recreational vehicle and one legally towed trailer that is not a trailer primarily designed as temporary living quarters for recreational or travel use;

"**recreational vehicle**" means a self-propelled vehicle or a trailer, primarily designed as temporary living quarters for recreational or travel use;

"**senior**" means a resident of the Province who is 65 years of age or older;

"**summer season**" means the period from June 15 to Labour Day;

“**youth group**” means a group of 12 or more persons

- (a) undertaking a camping trip or day use trip organized for the group by a BC k-12 school, not-for-profit society or recreational centre operated by a municipality or regional district for the benefit of the members of the group who are 18 years of age or younger; and,
- (b) supervised by a representative of the school, not-for-profit society or recreational centre who is 19 years of age or older;

"**vessel**" means a boat, canoe, kayak or other craft used, or capable of being used, for navigation on water.

Policy

The attached schedule of fees will apply during the operating season. Any changes to these fees, including promotional discounts and long-stay rates, must be approved by the minister under the appropriate policy.

Taxation of fees

- All fees are inclusive of applicable taxation.

Regular group camping fees

- The fee per night for the regular use of a frontcountry group campsite is calculated by adding together:
 - (1) the group camping base fee for the site established in the attached fee schedule; and,
 - (2) per person charges which are calculated by:
 - multiplying the number of adults (age 16+) by \$4, with a minimum charge of \$60 (15 adults); and,
 - multiplying the number of children (age 6 to 15) by \$1.

Youth group camping fee

- The fee per night for the use of a frontcountry group campsite by a youth group is \$1/person (age 6 and older) with a minimum charge of \$50/groupsite. The \$50/groupsite/night minimum includes the first 50 people. The maximum charge is \$150/groupsite/night.

Fees for vessels

- The fee for the overnight use of dock and mooring buoy facilities applies to vessels that tie or anchor to another vessel using the dock or mooring buoy facilities.
- Annual vessel permits are required for all commercial houseboat operations within provincial parks.

Second vehicle fees

- A party that is authorized by a park officer to have a second non-recreational vehicle on a campsite must pay ½ the camping fee being charged for that campsite, up to a maximum of \$12/night. Designated long-stay campsites are exempt from the fee for the second non-recreational vehicle.
- Second vehicle charges do not apply to group campsites, however vehicles which exceed the number of spots available in the booked group campsite may be charged the standard second vehicle fee if approval is given to park elsewhere in the park.

Backcountry

- The regular backcountry fee is \$5/person/night and applies to everyone 6 years of age and older.
- The premium backcountry fee will be charged in selected high use destinations and these parks will charge \$10/adult/night and \$5/child/night (6 to 15 year olds) as per the attached fee schedule.
- Day use parking fees are not required if the vehicle displays a valid backcountry camping receipt for within that park.

Disabled, volunteer and off-season fee exemptions

- A party containing one or more persons who produce BC Parks approved evidence of receiving federal or provincial income assistance for persons with disabilities do not pay frontcountry camping or parking fees.
- Volunteers working on projects, or providing a service, in a park, conservancy or recreation area that have been approved by a park officer do not pay frontcountry camping or parking fees (see Appendix 1 for more detail);.
- Frontcountry camping fees will not be charged in the off-season if no services are available.

Exemptions for children

- Children under 6 years old are not charged per person or per child recreation user fees (e.g. not charged for group camping, backcountry camping or cabins, Maquinna and Liard hot springs fees, Bowron Lakes canoe circuit fee and Tatshenshini river rafting fees).

Seniors' discount

- A seniors' discount is established in regulation. During the off-season (the period from the day after Labour Day to June 14 of the following year), British Columbia residents who are 65 years of age or older, pay one half of the summer season fee or the off-season rate, whichever is less, for a frontcountry campsite.
- A second vehicle (non-RV) may be allowed on site for an additional nightly charge of 1/2 the campsite fee paid by the senior (up to a maximum of \$12/night).
- This discount does not apply if the camping party includes an adult who is not a senior or the spouse of a senior (up to four seniors/spouses are allowed, children are allowed). This discount does not apply to group camping, group picnicking, backcountry, marine and day-use fees.

Appendix 1 – Volunteer Fee Exemption Procedures

Background:

- The fee exemption for volunteers is intended to support activities which provide benefits to BC Parks through:
 - the provision of visitor services (e.g. campground hosts, trail improvements, etc.),
 - increasing knowledge and understanding of protected areas (e.g. scientific research or park user studies), or
 - assisting in the management of protected areas (e.g. ecological reserve wardens, invasive weed control, etc).
- Section 11 of the BC Parks Recreation User Fees Regulation (the minister's regulation) allows volunteers to be exempted from front country camping and vehicle parking fees. The fee exemption requires prior approval of the volunteer project or service by a park officer.

Procedures:

- A volunteer is defined as someone who does not obtain remuneration for the engaged activity. More specifically:
 - Employees of the British Columbia Conservation Corps (BCCC) are paid a wage and are not considered volunteers.
 - Payment of a nominal stipend (e.g. Katimavik volunteers get paid \$3/day plus \$1000 at the end of 9 months) by a volunteer organization, university, or government program is permitted.
 - If the volunteer is eligible to be reimbursed for camping costs (or other recreation use fees) by a volunteer organization, university, or other government program, there will be no exemption from these fees by BC Parks.
 - Students working on research projects, even if this work is required as part of their graduation, can be considered volunteers if they are not being paid (and if there is no reimbursement of recreation user fees as per above).
 - "Working holidays" (commercial operations offering people the opportunity to do volunteer work in a park as part of a paid vacation) are not eligible for fee exemptions.
- The Volunteer Parking Pass can be used to approve one-time, short-term (up to 7 days) use of parking facilities by volunteers for projects/services with clearly defined start and finish dates. The parking pass can be conveyed by letter approved by the PPA SH. The letter should identify the volunteer individual/organization, the date, location and nature of the activity, and any other relevant facts about the intended project/service within the park.
- Exemptions from front-country camping fees and/or longer-term use of parking facilities require a volunteer agreement (Form #7 or 8, Volunteer Program Manual). The proposed volunteer generally completes a Volunteer Application form (Form # 5, Volunteer Program Manual) for BC Parks and fills in all relevant sections. BC Parks' staff will review the application and carry out necessary interviews, reference checks, Criminal Records check, etc. (if relevant). Application forms are not necessary where the volunteer is known to BC Parks and has an established relationship with regard to the intended volunteer activities.

However, a volunteer agreement is still required for all exemptions from camping fees and/or longer term use of parking facilities.

- Agreement with the PFO must be reached prior to approval of a volunteer project which involves fee exemptions. Certain conditions may warrant compensation to the Park Facility Operator, i.e. where the campground is full and one or more campsite(s) are being occupied by a BC Parks' volunteer. This is a revenue loss event not covered by the formal contractual Agreements with PFO's.
